Shrimporee Grounds will open on Friday, June 9th at 6:00 p.m. and remain open until 12:00 a.m. The Annual Shrimporee Parade starts @ 10:00 am in the downtown area with Shrimporee Grounds opening @ 11:00 a.m. and ending at 12:00 a.m. On Sunday, Shrimporee will run from Noon until 6:00 p.m.

The Shrimp Eating Contest (Main Stage Event) Men's & Women's Sexy Legs Contest, Folklorico Dancers, Mariachis, Belly Dancers, Kidz Korner with Identikid, Face Painting, Magic Show, Pony Rides Arts & Crafts, Games & Carnival are some of the activities on site.

This year we have two stages loaded with something for everyone. On the Main Stage is Tracy Lawrence, Reverends Daughter, Rockaholics, Ray T & the City Crew, A George Strait Tribute Band with Derek Spence, Three In A Row, Grupo Massore, Albert Zamora, Jaime y Los Chamacos, Clarissa Serna, Los Lonely Boys and much, much more..

The Allen Samuels Aransas Pass Stage will host a variety of fun, family entertainment through-out the day leading up to major entertainment at night while the HEB Stage will have a great line-up of bands performing continuously from opening on Friday to closing on Sunday. Along with great performers, visitors can expect to enjoy a wide variety of music from up and coming, as well as local artists. Both stages will be providing continuous entertainment that should appeal to young and old alike.
