HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- 1. **Download or Screenshot:** Participants can download the bingo card or take a screenshot on their phone.

- 3. **Social Media Posts:** For squares that require Facebook posts, participants can share on their Facebook page using posts, photos, or videos. Be sure to include the hashtag #APShopSmall and tag the Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce as well as the Aransas Pass business your post is promoting.
- 4. Marking Completes: Mark the squares you've completed.
- 5. **Submit Your Card:** Once you've completed a row, or column, submit your card to the Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce:

 - Drop-off: Alternatively, drop off a printed copy at the Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce (130 W. Goodnight Ave, Aransas Pass, TX 78336)
- 6. Deadline: All completed bingo cards must be submitted by November 30, 2024.
- 7. **Winners Announcement:** Three winners will be drawn on December 2, 2024, with each winner receiving a gift card to a local business!





- 1. **Economic Impact:** Local businesses reinvest a significant portion of their revenue back into the community. Studies show that for every \$100 spent at a local business, approximately \$68 stays in the community, compared to only \$43 when spent at a national chain.
- 2. **Job Creation:** Local businesses are vital for job creation. They provide more jobs per unit of sales compared to large chains, helping to reduce unemployment in the community.
- 3. **Community Character and Culture:** Local businesses contribute to the unique character of a community, enhancing its identity and making it a more attractive place to live and visit.
- 4. **Environmental Benefits:** Shopping local reduces transportation emissions, as goods are often sourced and sold closer to home. This can lead to a smaller carbon footprint.
- 5. **Personalized Service:** Local businesses often provide more personalized customer service, building relationships with customers and understanding their needs better than larger chains.
- 6. **Support for Local Causes:** Local businesses are more likely to support local charities, schools, and events, strengthening community ties and fostering a sense of belonging.

On average:

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- 68% of every dollar spent at a local business stays in the community, compared to 43% for national chains.
- When shopping at local businesses, that money circulates within the community multiple times, leading to more jobs, services, and opportunities for residents.
